In the provision of Air Navigation Services, Uganda Civil Aviation Authority management commits to;

- i. Take safety as their primary responsibility and is fully committed to all issues regarding safety.
- ii. Provide all necessary resources to enable the implementation of this safety policy and safety objectives.
- iii. The full implementation of all applicable, Civil Aviation Regulations, best practices and programs aimed at continually improving the SMS so as to achieve the highest standards of safety.
- iv. Promote mandatory, voluntary and confidential reporting to facilitate effective management of safety risks.
- v. Ensure that this safety policy is communicated, implemented and maintained at all levels within the directorate of ANS
- vi. Ensure that in the promotion of safety, disciplinary action shall not apply to outcomes of safety investigations resulting from human error unless such findings indicate beyond reasonable doubt, gross negligence or a deliberate or wilful disregard of the regulations or procedures.
- vii. To consider other UCAA policies in the implementation of this policy in order to enhance Safety performance.
- viii. Ensure that all staff at their respective levels participate in SMS activities in order to realise the intent of this policy.
